Probable Cause

On 05/11/2024, the DEFENDANT, Nadine Parker, violated Florida State Statute (F.S.S.) 827.03 (2)(c) -

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ABUSE CHILD WITHOUT GREAT BODILY HARM (2 COUNTS). This incident occurred at [REDACTED] FL, [REDACTED]

VICTIM (1) stated in a sworn verbal statement, he and the DEFENDANT got into a verbal altercation. The DEFENDANT attempted to gain affection from VICTIM (1) by hugging him. VICTIM (1) began telling DEFENDANT to stop. VICTIM (1) began trying to pull/push away from DEFENDANT and stated that DEFENDANT pulled him by the hair and hit him with a chair, in the back. VICTIM (1) gained control of a broom and attempted to put distance between he and DEFENDANT. DEFENDANT then grabbed VICTIM (1) and placed VICTIM (1) in a "choke hold". VICTIM (1) said he never lost the ability to breathe.

VICTIM (2) stated in a sworn verbal statement, he heard a disturbance in the living room between VICTIM (1) and DEFENDANT. VICTIM (2) stated when he arrived in the living room, he saw DEFENDANT holding VICTIM (1) in a "bear hug" type hold. VICTIM (2) stated he immediately pulled VICTIM (1) and DEFENDANT apart. VICTIM (2) stated he saw DEFENDANT "reach toward a table" which had several items on top. VICTIM (2) stated he believed DEFENDANT was reaching for "something to throw" at him. VICTIM (2) pushed DEFENDANT away from the items to prevent injury or damage. The DEFENDANT began a physical altercation. VICTIM (2) stated he tried to control the DEFENDANTS arms and restrain DEFENDANT. VICTIM (2) stated the DEFENDANT was pulling his hair and biting during the altercation. VICTIM (2) stated the resistance from the DEFENDANT eventually stopped at which time VICTIM (2) retreated to his bedroom and called 911.

Your AFFIANT observed there to be a small mark on the left hand to the webbing between the thumb and forefinger of VICTIM (2).

DEFENDANT initially refused to make any allegation of assault or battery. DEFENDANT did eventually make statements about VICTIM (1) and VICTIM (2) "attacking her" and that she "almost died" tonight. DEFENDANT had a small mark to the left hand to the webbing between the thumb and forefinger which DEFENDANT attributed to being bitten. DEFENDANT also had some redness to the chest below the collar bone.

No other injuries were observed. DEFENDANT was also intoxicated.

Based upon your AFFIANT'S investigation, there is probable cause to believe that the DEFENDANT, Nadine Parker, violated the aforementioned Florida State Statute. This offense is contrary to law, as such case provided, and against the peace and dignity of the State of Florida.
